TO CHANGE OVERTIME POLICY AND WORK PERIOD FOR POLICE AND FIRE PERSONNEL, FROM A 28 DAY WORK PERIOD (POLICE 171 HOURS BEFORE TIME AND ½ OVERTIME IS PAID & 212 HOURS FOR FIRE BEFORE TIME AND A HALF OVERTIME IS PAID) TO A 14 DAY WORK PERIOD THAT WOULD COINCIDE WITH THE PAY PERIOD (86 HOURS BEFORE TIME AND ONE HALF OVERTIME IS PAID

LENDING RATE TO ALL CITY OF MONTEZUMA DEPARTMENTS WILL BE 3% WITH A MAX PAYBACK OF 5 YEARS. ANY LOANS COMING FROM THIS ACCOUNT MUST HAVE APPROVAL OF THE MAJORITY OF COUNCIL PRIOR TO MAKING LOAN.
